HEAD COACH, ALLAN VINCE THE MASTER'S UNIVERSITY

Allan Vince is visiting the Antelope Valley from Newhall, California via the Master's University. Allan has been at the helm at TMU since 2014. Ever since he took over, the program has flourished and has been a big competitor in the GSAC as well as the NAIA. Before Allan took over TMU, he was the assistant coach for the Cal Baptist University Men's Team. He was also the assistant coach for Team USA during the 2013 Pan American Games on the men's side. As a player, Allan played for UCLA where they finished 2nd in the 2005 National Championships. After UCLA, Allan competed for TEAM USA and also played professionally for international clubs.



HEAD COACH, BRANDEN HIGA CAL BAPTIST UNIVERSITY

Branden Higa returns to visit Antelope Valley College from Cal Baptist University. Branden became the head coach at CBU in 2012. Since Branden's last visit, he was named 2017 AVCA Division 2 National Coach of the Year. During the 2017 season, the CBU Lancers won the PAC West Conference being undefeated, and earned the National Ranking of #1 going into the NCAA Playoffs with a record of 28-0. Branden has also been named Coach for the Team USA Collegiate National Team which is made up of collegiate all-stars representing USA in a world tournament held in Europe. Before CBU, Branden was the assistant coach for Mississippi State University, Loyola Marymount University, and Lipscomb University. He was also head coach for West LA College. In addition to coaching at universities and colleges, Branden has coached for various club programs and was the assistant coach for USA Beach Volleyball. Branden was a standout star while playing for Quartz Hill High School. He went on to play for Pierce College where he was named California State Player of the Year, 1994, then transferred on to continue playing at Pepperdine University.
